

## **ÖZGÜR GÜNAYDIN**

Born in Muğla in 1969, Özgür Günaydın graduated from the Mechanical Engineering Department of Middle East Technical University (METU). He received his Executive MBA degree from Sabancı University and completed the Stanford University Leadership Academy. Günaydın joined Borusan Cat in 1995 as a service engineer, serving as the Istanbul Regional Manager and subsequently managing the company's international operations for 10 years. In this role, he was responsible for Borusan Cat operations in Kazakhstan, Azerbaijan, Georgia, and Kyrgyzstan. As of January 1, 2017, Günaydın assumed the position of CEO of Borusan Cat and continues to serve as a Founding Member of the Caterpillar Digital Council, a Member of the Caterpillar Dealer Advisory Group, and a member of the Caterpillar Mining Council, carrying out forward-looking work within the global Caterpillar ecosystem. Günaydın is a member of the Foreign Economic Relations Board (DEİK), which contributes to the development of Turkey's foreign economic relations, and also serves on the Turkish-American Business Council (TAİK), which aims to improve trade and investment relations between Turkey and the United States. He is also a member of AmCham Turkey, a business association and non-governmental organization comprised of US companies operating in Turkey, and has spearheaded the initiation of AmCham memberships in countries where Borusan Cat operates. Günaydın also contributes to the sustainability efforts of the United Nations Global Compact Turkey. Prioritizing projects focused on social benefit, Günaydın serves on the Board of Directors of KODA, a non-governmental organization supporting the improvement of educational conditions in disadvantaged regions of Turkey. As of April 2026, Günaydın continues to serve as Group CEO of Borusan Group and will also serve on the Board of Directors of Borusan Pipe as of May 2026.
